# 2018 Xi State Scholarship Application Now Available

The Xi State Scholarship Committee under the leadership of chair Marsha Rains has updated the 2018 application for members seeking financial assistance with expenses for earning advanced degrees.

- 1. Scholarships available to be awarded:
  - a. The Lois Jones Special (Stipend of \$3000) for pursuing a doctorate (Ph.D., Ed.D., J.D.).
  - b. Isabel Wheeler (Stipend of \$3000) for pursuing a doctorate (Ph.D., Ed.D., J.D.).
  - c. Maycie K. Southall (Stipend of \$3000) for study beyond the Master's Degree.
  - d. Mary Hall (Stipend of \$3000) for study beyond the Bachelor's Degree.
  - e. Evangeline Hartsook (Stipend of \$1250) for study beyond the Bachelor's Degree.
  - f. Lottye McCall (Stipend of \$1250) for study beyond the Bachelor's Degree.
  - g. Louise Oakley (Stipend of \$1250) for study beyond the Bachelor's Degree.
  - h. Eleanor Osteen (Stipend of \$1250) for study beyond the Bachelor's Degree.

\*Not all scholarships will be awarded each year; decisions to award or not will be made based on availability of funding and/or the number of qualified applicants

- 2. Eligibility:
  - a. Applicants must be members of a Xi State chapter for at least three calendar years.
  - b. Service to Delta Kappa Gamma is an important criterion in the selection of a recipient.

c. Applications that are electronically submitted on/before the deadline (**February 1**<sup>st</sup> of the year awarded) and are complete will be scored using the Application Review Form. A minimum score is required to be considered for a scholarship. Please review this rubric carefully.

#### Incomplete or late applications will not be eligible for consideration.

d. Former recipients of a major scholarship (\$3,000) may not reapply.

The application and rubric are attached to this issue of *Leadership Links* and are available on the Xi State web site. Please be aware that the new application process requires online submission of information via Google Docs so applicants will need to create a Google email account including a photo. ## High School Essay Contest Deadlines December 8 and 15

The often-quoted American journalist Sydney J. Harris once wrote:

"Most people are mirrors, reflecting the moods and emotions of the times; few are windows, bringing light to bear on the dark corners where troubles fester. The whole purpose of education is to turn mirrors into windows."

While the students may incorporate this quotation in any way they wish, it must be the basis of their essay. The students may agree or disagree with the writer's statement as they support their own opinions. The students may also choose to draw on their own personal experiences or observations to illustrate their point.

The guidelines for submitting essays have changed. Essays will be submitted electronically, instead of being mailed. A Gmail account has been set up to receive the electronic submissions. The contest information, guidelines, deadlines, and cover sheet are posted on the Xi State website and were included in the October and November *Leadership Links*.

The student will email his/her essay to one school official (teacher, guidance counselor, instructional coach, etc.). The school official will email the essays to the contact person of the sponsoring DKG chapter by **December 8, 2017**. The contact person of the sponsoring DKG chapter will attach all of the essays from the school in one email and send them to xistate.essay@gmail.com by **December 15, 2017**.

In the case that a chapter is sending essays from more than one school, each school's essays should be sent in separate emails. In the subject line indicate your chapter name and the name of the school. If you have any questions, you can email State Projects co-chair Allison Maynard at <u>allison814@comcast.net</u>.
